Should we worry?

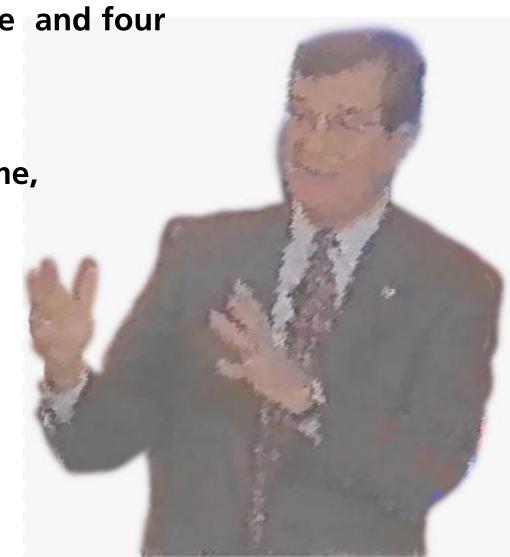

- (b) the potential difference between points P and Q



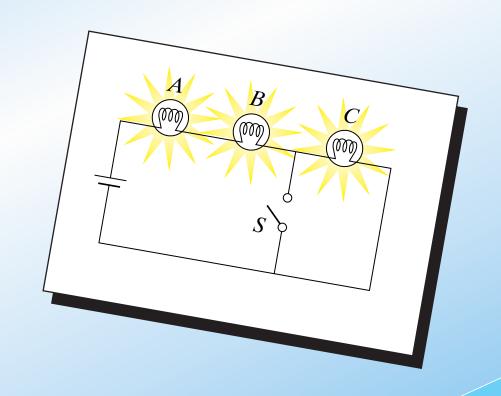












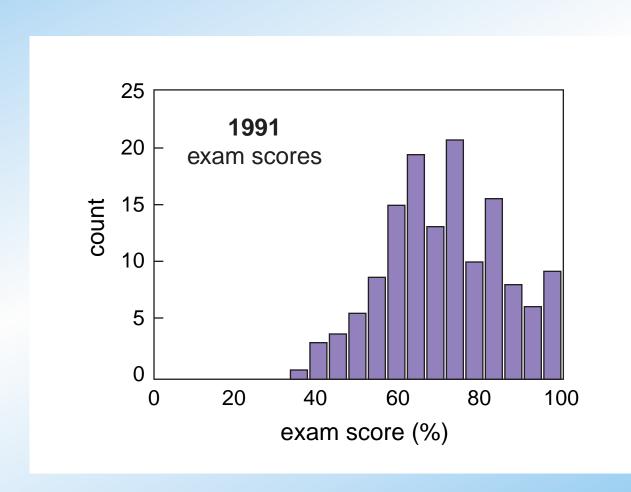


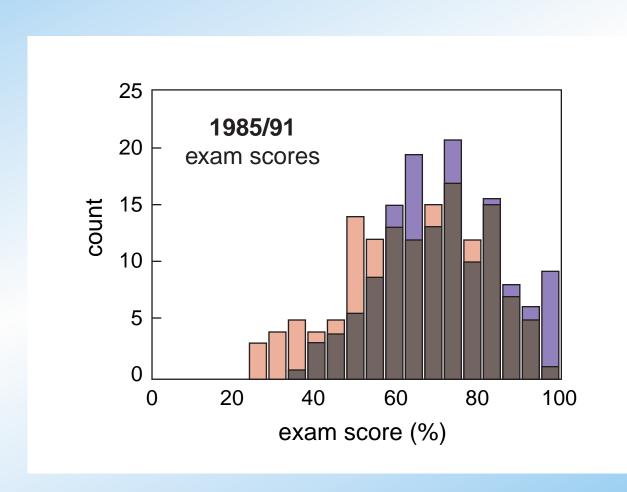




What about problem solving...?
